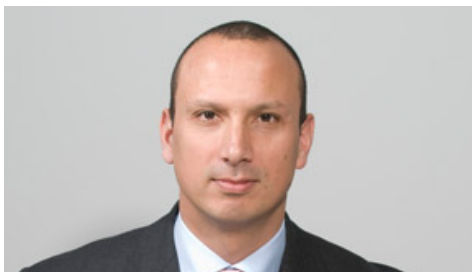


Kick off Spanish Presidency of the EU ICT Sector
