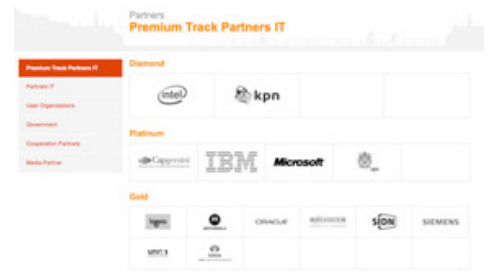
Various inspiring names confirmed
